

Telephone Use Policy

The Lyons Public Library Board of Trustees allows use of the telephone by the public under the following circumstances:

- 1.) Patron is sick and needs medical help or someone to come and pick him/her up.
- 2.) A patron's car has broken down and needs to call relative or a garage.
- 3.) A child needs to call and have relative come and pick him/her up.
- 4.) A child needs to call parent and let parent know that he/she stopped at the library on the way home.
- 5.) If patron has been physically threatened by another person, patron may call home for a ride or call police to report incident.

The telephone is not to be used by the public to conduct business or to call relatives/friends to just talk. At the sole discretion of the librarian, the telephone may be used for other purposes.
